

Pre-K Remote Learning Plan

Journal Question (10 minutes): Each day in class your child answers a daily question. Ask your child the question and have them draw a response. You can then ask your child to explain their response and write down their dictation.

Read Aloud (10 minutes): Listen to the assigned read aloud link with your child. Or read any book from your home book collection. Make sure to ask your child some comprehension questions such as:


1. What happened first in the story?
2. What happened at the end of the story?
3. What was your favorite part of the story and why?
4. What do you think will happen after the book ends?
5. How do the characters feel during the story?
